I am a recipient of one of your Gun Locks when they were being passed out at a church in Detroit on 12/21/06, and on a closer examination of the product, I must admit that I am impressed, and I applaud you for your invention, and interest in gun safety.

As a retired law enforcement officer, and one who has had the unfortunate duty making notification to families of the often tragic and senseless loss of life of their loved ones, it never got any easier to do, and the violent acts continued to occur.

And in these uncertain times in our society, gun violence seems to be prevalent in the urban areas of our communities, without regard of age of its victims.


Even as I sit here, the local news announces that two women in Detroit have been shot to death (mother and daughter) by a disgruntled and drunken boyfriend, and that the son of a Detroit Police officer (15 years old) located the key to the gun lock box and while displaying the gun to his friends, the weapon discharged and killed one of his friends.

A further example of how our society has continued to be a society that either settles their disputes with deadly force, or are excited about guns so much that the careless use of them result in a crippling, maiming injury or death.

I have seen the pain of families preparing to bury a loved one over the past thirty years, and have been the first on the scene of senseless violence driven by the use of handgun, with the ending results of one life behind bars for the rest of his/her life, and only a memory of the deceased for the other family. These acts destroy our family structure, and continue to produce the staggering statistics on incarceration and deaths of blacks in this country.

In closing, again, I applaud and congratulate you on this technology, presenting it to the public in an earnest effort to reduce gun violence by securing those weapons that are in so many homes today.
